



Call for Submissions for BOOG CITY Baseball Issue

Submissions are open to a special section of Boog City 140 on the theme of the baseball from June 1, 2020 to August 1, 2020. Do not submit outside this window. The issue will be released in early October, in conjunction with the World Series. All submissions will receive responses by September 15, 2020.

Poet and essayist Sandra Marchetti is the guest editor for the baseball section. Sandra Marchetti is the author of *Confluence*, a full-length collection of poetry from Sundress Publications (2015). She is also the author of four chapbooks of poetry and lyric essays. Marchetti's baseball poetry appears widely in *Baseball Prospectus*, *Poet Lore*, *Blackbird*, *FanGraphs' The Hardball Times*, *Southwest Review*, and elsewhere. Her prose on the game can be found at *Barrelhouse*, *Entropy*, *Hobart*, and *Pleiades*. She earned an M.F.A. in creative writing—poetry from George Mason University and serves as the coordinator of tutoring services at the College of DuPage in the Chicagoland area.

- Poetry: please send 2-4 poems in a single Word attachment via the email address below.
- Prose: send one prose piece under 1,000 words as a Word attachment via the email address below.
- Art: send 2-4 visuals as jpeg or pdf attachments. We are looking for comics, cartoons, photographs, and other forms of visual art. One piece will be chosen as the cover image.
- Include a short cover letter in the body of your email with a third-person bio and your contact info.
- Simultaneous submissions are allowed. Please notify us immediately via email if the entirety of your submission or part of it is accepted elsewhere.
- Up to one piece in your submission can be previously published in print or online (please indicate in your cover letter which piece is previously published and where).
- In the subject line of your email, please write your name and genre, ex: "Babe Ruth—Poetry Submission." Send all submissions to
